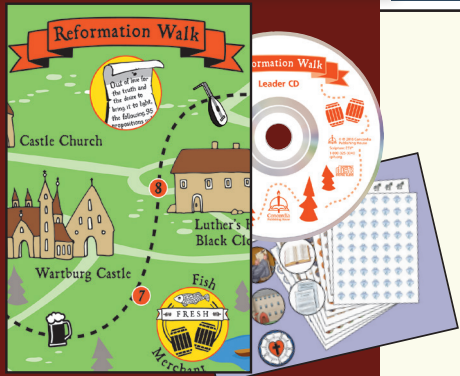

Reformation Walk

This outreach or congregational event takes participants on a historical walk about the life and ministry of Martin Luther.

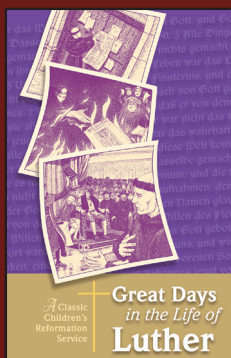
On their journey, participants interact with historical figures, share a snack, play a game, sing, and make a keepsake Luther's seal.



ALL AGES

- About twelve to fifteen volunteers. Decorations—Some décor can be used from the *Mighty Fortress* VBS.
- Costumes are needed.
- Sticker sheets for your Reformation Day "maps." One pack provides stickers for 63 participants. Maps are printed from the Reformation Walk CD.

2 hours to visit all stations at a single event



Great Days in the Life of Luther, A Classic Children's Reformation Service

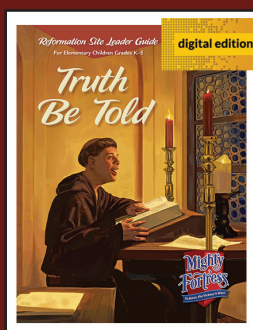
Through a dramatic use of tableaux, children act out a significant moment or scene from Luther's life to teach the congregation the story of the Reformation. A Scripture lesson, homily, and hymns are included in the service, reminding everyone about the important truths rediscovered by Martin Luther—that by grace and faith in Christ alone, we are saved. Revisit this classic from years ago to celebrate Reformation history.



ALL AGES

- One teen or adult for narrations and speaking parts.
- Two to seventeen children or young adults for costumed roles.
- Decorations.
- Costumes are needed.

Truth Be Told (Digital Edition)

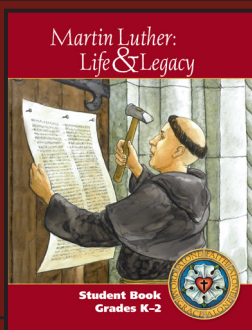
This five-day curriculum teaches children about five key events in the life of Martin Luther and the truths he found in God's Word. Activities, stories, snacks, crafts, and games connect those events to God's work through Martin Luther and through us. Use in Sunday School, as a thematic unit in Day School, for a family event, or as a Reformation celebration.



GRADES K-5

- Decorations—Some décor can be used from the *Mighty Fortress* VBS.
- Curriculum includes ideas for crafts, games, and other activities that the purchaser will need to provide separately.

Martin Luther: Life & Legacy

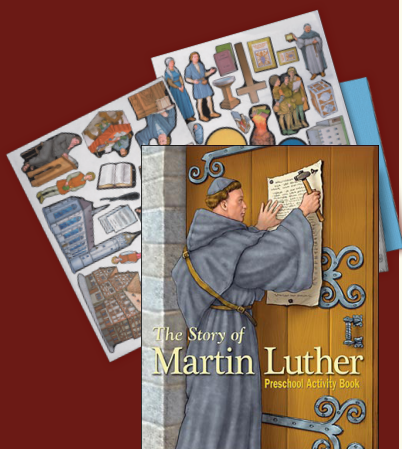
Offers a keepsake student activity book on four levels for students to explore the life and teachings of Martin Luther through articles and activities. Each teacher book provides a framework for teaching lessons in the student book and additional activity suggestions for older levels.



GRADES K-8

- Downloadable teacher book for each level.
- One book per student.

20-35 minutes for each of 4 sessions



Martin Luther Flannelgraph with Teacher Guide and The Story of Martin Luther Preschool Activity Book

This guide includes 39 figures and objects to help teach young children about the life of Martin Luther. The teacher guide included with the flannelgraph includes a five-session plan for preschool level, and separate five-session plan for the K-2 level.

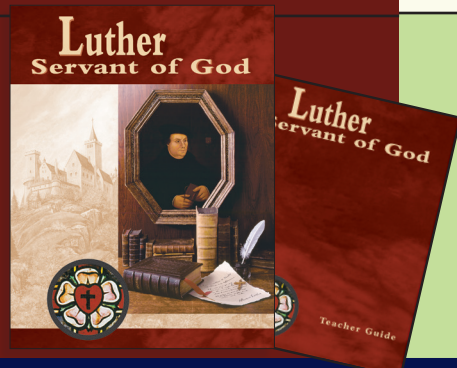
The Story of Martin Luther Preschool Activity Book is integrated with the preschool level sessions. It includes eight activity pages, stickers, and two songs. Used with the flannelgraph or as a stand-alone activity



PRESCHOOL-2

- One activity book per student.

20-35 minutes for each of 5 sessions



Luther: Servant of God

Provides a student book and teacher guide. The teacher guide provides background reading for the teacher and lesson outlines, activity answers, project notes, and a course review and assessment. The student book contains readings, activity questions, and project suggestions.



GRADES 6-8

- One book per student.

20-35 minutes for each of 17 sessions
